6. To provide a global platform for sharing best practices, research insights, and future-ready educational ideas.

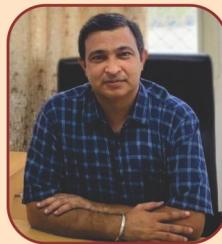

- Authors should include 4-6 keywords that represent the core topics of their research.
